Research has demonstrated the significant edge that a Montessori education provides to students.

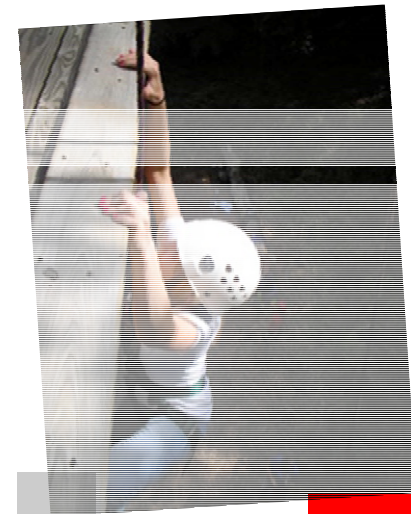
- **Cognitively** through enhanced creative and critical thinking.

Learning in Montessori

- Montessori curriculum & methodology are the same at every Montessori school.

- Students practice service-learning.
- Expectations for learning are high! Assessment is based on 90% mastery.
