KG	Kindergarten Readiness and Movement ABC's	Be prepared for kindergarten! Children become familiar with the routines of school while using fine motor skills, using numbers, and developing pre-reading skills.
1st	English Language Learners (ELL) Levels 1 & 2	Activities promote English reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills.
1st	HAL—Face to Face —Cancelled	Discover faces of the world in art, astronomy, geometry, myths, folktales, and fairy tales.
1st	Music, Movement & Drama	Dance, play instruments, and act out songs and stories.
1st	Reading and Math Skills	Increase reading and math readiness for first grade.
1st	Simple Spanish	Learn simple conversation skills including colors, numbers, and family relationships.
2nd	Reading and Math Skills	Increase reading and math readiness for second grade.
2nd-3rd	Author Exploration —Cancelled	Explore various authors and literature genres through collaboration and communication using Skype and other digital tools.
2nd-3rd	English Language Learners (ELL) Levels 1 & 2	Activities promote English reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills.
2nd-3rd	HAL—#Symbolsaroundtheworld —Cancelled	Explore current and ancient symbols through geography, math, and literature. Discover how symbols apply to everyday life.
